BROKERS COMMENT'S

The aim for the successful design of the Najad 440 was to create a luxury, highly exclusive and superb sailing yacht, capable of being handled comfortably, effective and safety by a crew of one or two persons.

The outcome from the combination of naval architect Judel/Vrolijk & Co, interior designer Rhodes Young and Najadvarvets craftsmen, was a ground-breaking, exceptional 'world class' yacht. Najad 440 is equally suited to the ocean adventurer as to the gentler life of costal cruising and island hopping.

Najad 440 comes in two different versions, AC (aft cockpit) and CC (center cockpit). This Najad 440 FLYING PENGUIN is an CC version that was delivered in 2008. This means it offers well protected cockpit ideal for ocean sailing where all sailhandling and instruments are always close to you. The sprayhood and cockpit tent offers good protection also in cold climate sailing conditions.

The interior layout offers a large owners aft cabin with double berths and a suite toilet with shower. The forward guest cabin also offers a double berth, a suite toilet with shower and plenty of storage space. A large gally is



located to port of the entrance extending aft wards and the navigation table with a comfortable seat is located directly to starboard of the entrance. The saloon has a C-sofa to port and two seats to starboard. A superb layout for an ocean going yacht!

The interior is made of selected mahogany with floorboards in Jatoba and blue coloured upholstery.

At the moment FLYING PENGUIN is on route from Caribbean to Europe on board a freight ship. The yacht is planned to arrive in Germany in the beginning of June and should be in Henån, at Berthon Scandinavia's showing dock, around beginning of July!

OWNERS COMMENT'S

We bought the yacht in Fort Lauderdale 2017 from the first Swedish owner and had it shipped to Sweden in the autumn of 2017. During 2018 we made a general upgrade in order to have the best modern equipment for our sailing trip and stay in the Caribbean. We have been sailing this area of the world and had a fantastic time onboard, now for almost 2 years. FLYING PENGUIN will soon be shipped back to Europe and be available at Berthon Scandinavia's showing dock in Henån from approx. end of June 2021. Now the FLYING PENGUIN is set for the next owner and looking forward to new adventures.



INTERIOR

General

Layout: Sleep 4 persons in 2 cabins with double berth, galley, 2 x heads / shower, saloon and navigation area Handmade interior of selected African mahogany Floor boards in varnished dark wood with inlaid stripes Inspection hatches in floorboards Headlining of creme white covered panels Plenty of storage space in shelves, cabinets and closets God ventilation

Forward cabin

Forward cabin there is a full width double berth and a wardrobe on the starboard side with spacious cupboards underneath. There is a large stowage facility underneath the berth. An opening skylight can be used as an emergency exit or for ventilation purpose. A heads/shower is located directly to port within the area of the forward cabin

Forward Heads / Shower

Light and spacious. Built with white laminated bulkheads including wash basin, bench surface and shower floor made of Kerock® material. Electrical toilet - 2019. Mirror.

Saloon

Exclusive entrance stairs with shaped footsteps and stainless steel handrail covered with leather. A foldable table with a locker for bottles. Sofas to PT and 2 chairs to SB, plenty of cabinets and book shelfs



Navigation area

Navigations area to starboard of the entrance stairs. Large navigation table, drawers, comfortable seat, space for instruments

Galley

The galley is located to PT of the entrance stair, extending aft wards. Plenty of storage spaces, cupboards, drawers, dry storage and shelfs. Kerock® worktop with twin sinks and a chopping board over one sink Gas stove, 2 burners with oven and grill Force 10 - 2017

Aft cabin (Owners cabin)

A passageway on the port leads to the aft cabin, which includes a wide double berth amidships and sufficient stowage for extended periods at sea. Seats on each side of the berth. Spot lights and reading lights positioned for comfortable reading. The bed base is unvarnished and ventilated with holes to minimise dampness. Two fixed portholes in the hull and two openable skylights for ventilation. Heads/shower is located to starboard with entrance from the aft cabin

Aft Heads / Shower

Light and very spacious. Built with white laminated bulkheads including wash basin, bench surface and shower floor made of Kerock® material. Electric Toilet. Mirror.
