BROKER'S COMMENTS

The Bavaria 32 Sport is a well-planned sport cruiser that feels larger than its thirty two feet. With its generous beam, inviting cockpit and thoughtful layout with two cabins and a saloon, the model offers a combination of space, comfort and easy handling. It is appreciated for its stable behaviour through the water and for providing a straightforward and secure experience.

The cockpit serves as the natural meeting point on board, with teak flooring, a wide bathing platform and an aft seating area that creates a pleasant and social space with good access to the water. Below deck you are met by a bright and spacious saloon with galley, heads compartment and a roomy forward berth. Aft there is a separate cabin with a wide double berth, wardrobe and small sofa. The layout makes longer stays on board possible and comfortable for a smaller family, despite the boat's size.

The boat is easy to handle, and the twin Volvo Penta 4.3 GXI engines provide smooth acceleration and stable running. Manoeuvring is assisted by the bow thruster, trim tabs and electric windlass installations both forward and aft, making the boat easy to dock even in tighter harbours.

This 2006 example is in good condition for her age. The underwater hull was blasted and rebuilt in 2023 and the canopy from the same year gives the cockpit a fresh overall impression. The galley and wet bar have been improved with two new stainless steel refrigerators and a newer stove, and at the helm the seat and wheel have been upgraded. A newer stereo and sound system together with the oiled teak in the cockpit create a modern and well-kept appearance. The boat has been stored indoors in a heated hall during winter, which has helped maintain her excellent condition.

The Bavaria 32 Sport offers good comfort and is both easy to handle and economical to own. With her upgrades, equipment and well preserved condition, this example offers a lot of boat for the money. The boat may remain stored in the heated hall until spring at no additional cost and can be delivered launched if desired. Contact the broker for more information.

CONSTRUCTION

RCD Status: The yacht conforms with the essential safety requirements of Directive 94/25EC or RCDII (2013/53/EU as appropriate (Recreational Craft Directive) and is categorised B.

Hull, Deck & Superstructure Construction:

- Hand laid GRP hull with V bottom in polyester.
- Single laminate below water line and sandwich laminate above.
- GRP deck and superstructure in polyester, with sandwich construction and balsa core in flat deck areas and PVC foam core on topsides.
- Hull, deck and superstructure in white gelcoat with moulded non slip areas on foredeck and side decks.
- Teak laid cockpit sole and bathing platform.
- Integrated bathing platform moulded as part of the hull and transom, with stainless steel bathing ladder.
- Stainless steel framed skylights, portlights and windows in the superstructure.
- Stainless steel bow roller, bow rails and guardrails along the side decks that tie into the deck and hull structure.
- Volume produced interior and deck modules bonded into the GRP hull.



ACCOMMODATION

Summary of Accommodation:

- Sleeps 5 people in total. 4 in 2 cabins and 1 in the saloon sofa.
- Forward cabin, aft cabin, and an occasional berth in the saloon.
- Lowerable saloon table with seating for 4–5 in U-sofa.
- Spacious and fully equipped galley suitable for extended stays on board.
- A separate head and shower compartment and electric toilet.
- Large sliding plexi door access the saloon/cockpit.
- Interior woodwork in clear varnished mahogany-inspired wood.
- Flooring in mahogany-inspired wood.
- Several portlight with curtains and skylights.
- White GRP ceiling with light grey inner liner panels.
- Beige coloured Interior in mahogany-coloured wood finish.
- Beige leather upholstery and carpet.
- Curtains and blinds for skylights and portlights.
- Plenty of ceiling lights with additional reading lights in the forward cabin.
- Overhead storage cabinets along both sides of the saloon and forward cabin.
- Three wardrobes and ample storage throughout the boat.
- White leather cockpit upholstery.

DECK EQUIPMENT

General:

- Raised bow pulpit with sturdy stainless-steel railings.
- Bow platform for safe boarding, with anchor and bow roller below.
- Solid stainless-steel guardrail surrounding the deck.
- Large foredeck locker and four stainless-steel fender holders mounted on guardrail.
- Spacious foredeck sunbathing area with stainless-steel drink holders.
- Self-draining, non-slip deck surface.
- Wide walkaround side decks providing safe passage on both sides of the cockpit.
- Stainless-steel handholds on the cockpit arch and on each side of the integrated bathing platform.
- Stainless-steel bathing ladder recessed beneath teak-covered hatch.

Cockpit:

- Helms position with engine instruments, control panels and navigational equipment.
- Co-pilot sofa for three people.
- White upholstered cushions in cockpit.
- Oiled teak floor.
- Drink holders.
- Wet bar with refrigerator.
- Speakers and subwoofer.
- Two straight aft sofas with small dining table. Sofa convertible to sunbed.
- Several storage compartments.
- Generous standing height under blue canopy and GRP cockpit arch.
- Self-draining cockpit.
- Stainless steel door giving access to the bathing platform.
- Seawater outlet for deck and cockpit washdown – never used by current owner.
- Shower with hot and cold water on bathing platform.

Anchoring & Mooring Equipment:

- Bow: Electric windlass (Quick), 10kg galvanized anchor & 40 meter of galvanized chain.
- Stern: Electric windlass, 10kg stainless steel anchor & 40 meter of line.
- 6 x Stainless steel deck cleats.
- 4 x Fenders and 4 x mooring lines.

SAFETY EQUIPMENT

Fire-Fighting Equipment:

- 1 x Fire extinguishers.
- Auto fire system in engine room – unknown functionality.
